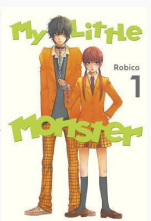
TO YOUR ETERNITY

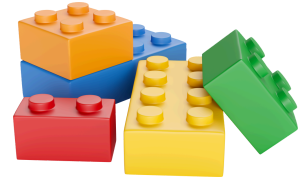
